Ordinance

NO. 22-027

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND SETTING WAGES, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 19-032, AND ANY ORDINANCE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, $\frac{3}{4}$'s of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio, hereby creates the position of a part-time police officer in the Police Department. Said duties of part-time police officer are as follows:

Same powers and authorities as have been granted to regular full-time Struthers Police Officers.

SECTION 2: Part-time Police Officer shall receive \$15.00 per hour, effective upon passage. Said employee shall be paid time and a half on holidays worked.

SECTION 3: Each part-time police officer must have completed Ohio Peace Officer Basic Training Program, and be a member in good standing of the Struthers Police Reserves.

SECTION 4: Each part-time Police Officer shall be appointed by the Mayor on a yearly basis. He or she shall be directly responsible to the Turn-Captains and under the over-all supervision of the Chief of Police and Safety Service Director. Each part-time Police Officer shall be in the unclassified services.

SECTION 5: It is understood that said person is eligible for no fringe benefits and shall work an average of twenty-eight (28) hours per week, not to exceed one thousand four hundred fifty six (1,456) hours per calendar year.

SECTION 6: That ordinance No. 19-032 and any ordinance inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: This ordinance is effective upon passage.

SECTION 8: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Struthers, Ohio. Said emergency exists by reason of the fact and part-time employees get paid, as such, this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
