**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING 2024-2028 MAHONING COUNTY  
MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN  
UPDATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, natural, technological, and man-made hazards can affect the City of Struthers in Mahoning County; and

**WHEREAS**, significant structural, historical, and economic losses could result from an occurrence of a natural, technological, or man-made hazard events; and

**WHEREAS**, undertaking mitigation projects during pre-disaster periods could decrease the total losses the City of Struthers incurs as a result of said hazard occurrences; and

**WHEREAS**, the Struthers City Council has a strong interest in reducing losses from future hazard occurrences; and

**WHEREAS**, the hazard mitigation plan is a federal and state requirement to maintain eligibility for hazard mitigation funding, and, by that requirement, must be updated a minimum of every five (5) years; and

**WHEREAS**, a cooperative, joint effort is a proven, efficient way to plan for and reduce hazard susceptibility in all government jurisdictions in Mahoning County, Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mahoning County Emergency Management Agency, utilizing RFG Associates of Zainesville, Ohio, has updated the Mahoning County Hazard Mitigation Plan utilizing a steering Committee that included all political subdivisions in Mahoning County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mahoning County Hazard Mitigation Plan was adopted by the Board of Mahoning County Commissioners in Resolution 24-07-015; and

**WHEREAS**, to maintain eligibility for hazard mitigation funding, City of Struthers must also adopt the Mahoning County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Struthers City Council has partnered with the Mahoning County Emergency Management Agency and the other jurisdictions in the county to update the existing Mahoning County 2024-2028 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, in an effort to further identify, define, and characterize the hazards affecting the city as well as to continue identifying and prioritizing projects that could lesson hazard vulnerability.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that Struthers City Council does hereby adopt the updated Mahoning County 2024-2028 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan this 11<sup>th</sup> day of DECEMBER, 2024; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Struthers, Ohio,  $\frac{3}{4}$ 's of all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1:** A copy of said Mahoning County 2024-2028 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan is marked Exhibit "A" and made a part thereof.

**SECTION 2:** That it is FOUND and DETERMINED that all formal actions of this Council relating to the passage of this Resolution or adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were made in compliance with all legal requirements, including those of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.




