**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY OF
STRUTHERS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DYNEGY ENERGY
SERVICES EAST, LLC AS THE ELECTRIC SUPPLIER FOR THE CITY OF
STRUTHERS ELECTRIC ACCOUNTS AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Struthers, County of Mahoning and State of Ohio, $\frac{3}{4}$'s of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to make and enter into an Electric Service Agreement with Dynegy Energy Services East, LLC for electric generation services for the city's own accounts.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: A copy of said Agreement with Dynegy Energy Services East, LLC is marked Exhibit "A" and attached hereto and made a part thereof.

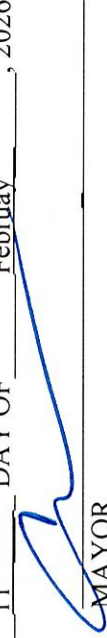
SECTION 4: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Struthers, and provided it receives the two-thirds vote of all members of Council elected thereto, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
